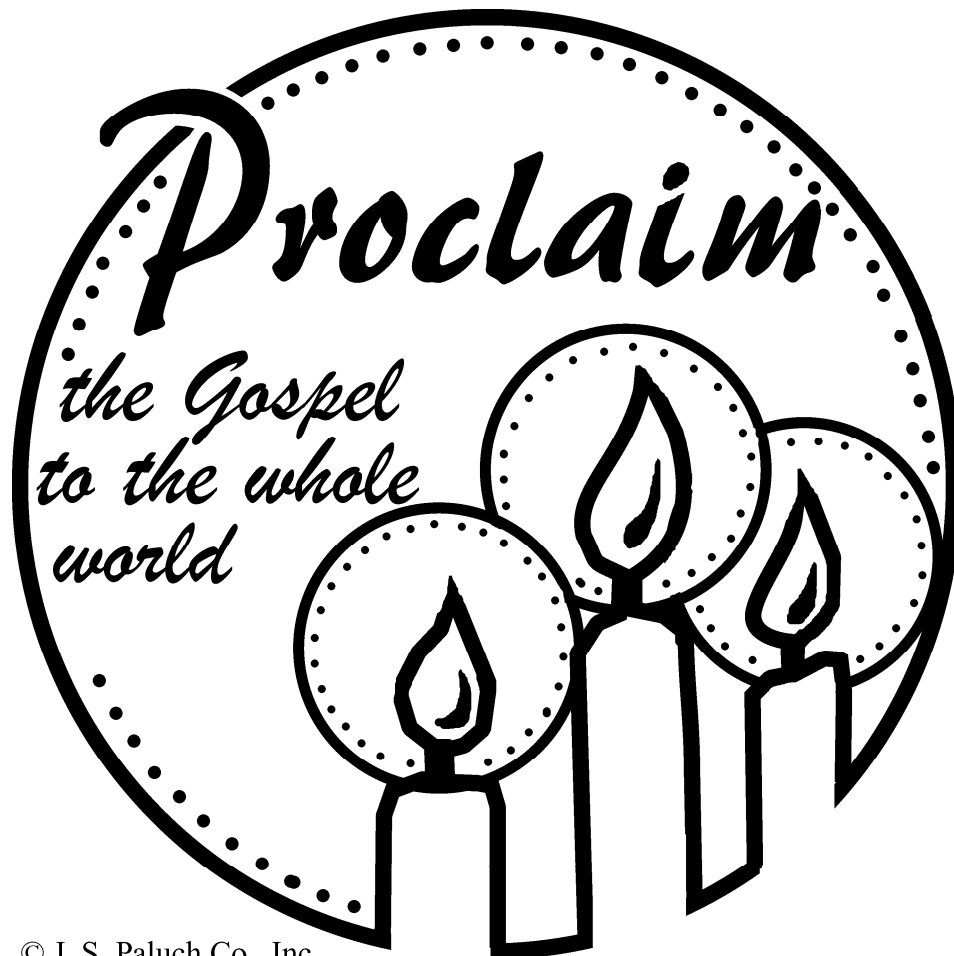

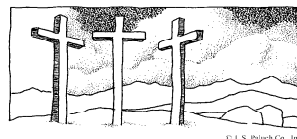
ANNOUNCEMENTS AT MASS
