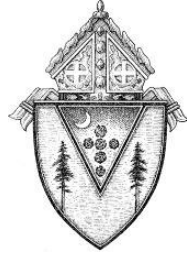

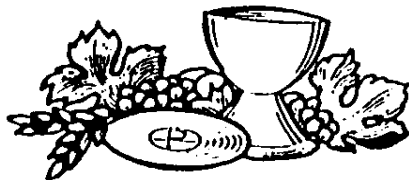

They are now partnering with the McLean Foundation to create a multigenerational center. The roof on the building is in need of repair. The Finance Council will be reviewing bids at their quarterly meeting this coming week. Although Humboldt Senior Services continues to rent the building from the parish, the upkeep of the building itself is our responsibility. The McLean Foundation will be making some modifications to the interior of the building, but we need to repair the roof. Look for future updates as we select a contractor and schedule the start of the work.



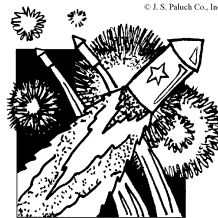
