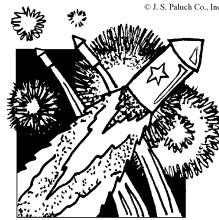


Let's gather with other citizens of faith to pray that our government stays sensitive to our right to follow our consciences. Please join us for a prayer service on Sunday,

CONTRACTOR NEEDED

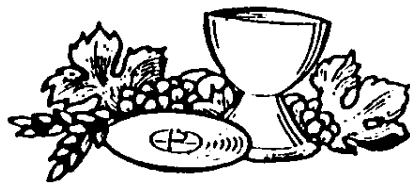
