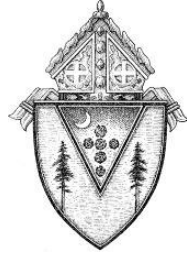

EWTN's Special Programs in July include "Felix Varela," a documentary on the life of a 19th century priest whose writings on Cuban independence from Spain were a source of inspiration to Cuban national hero Jose Marti. The Holy See has authorized the opening of the process of canonization for Fr. Varela. The documentary airs July 27 at 7 p.m. & July 28 at 11 a.m. "Walsingham: England's Nazareth" sets forth the history of Our Lady of Walsingham in Norfolk, a place of pilgrimage since medieval times. The special program airs July 29 at 7 p.m. & July 31 at 10 a.m. All times are Pacific Time. **USCCB Natural Family Planning Week:
July 22-28, 2012**

Faithfully Yours is the theme of this year’s Natural Family Planning (NFP) week. Natural Family Planning methods represent authentic family planning. They can be used to both achieve and to postpone a pregnancy. NFP makes use of periodic abstinence from sexual intercourse based upon the observation of the woman’s natural signs of fertility, in order to space births or to limit the number of children when there is a serious reason to do so... this practice fosters in couples an attitude of respect and wonder in the face of human life, which is sacred. It also fosters profound respect for one’s spouse, which is necessary for authentic intimacy.
