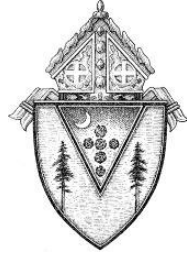

ANNUAL BUDGET REPORT

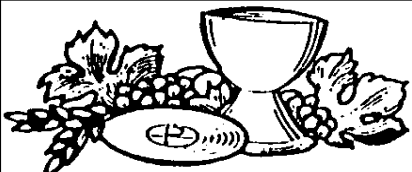

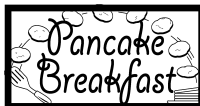
