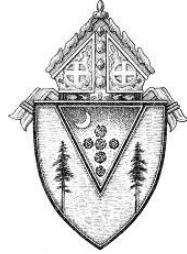

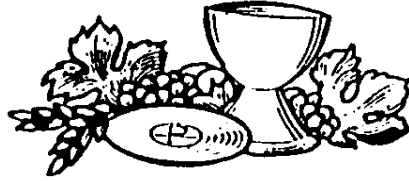

PANCAKE BREAKFAST YUM!

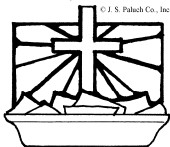
