Bl. Pope John Paul II 1920 — 2005 Beatified May 1, 2011 Karol Józef Wojtyła, born on May 18, 1920, in Wadowice, Poland, was ordained a priest in 1946, a bishop in 1958, was appointed archbishop of Kraków in 1964, and elevated to the College of cardinals in 1967. When he was elected the 264th successor of Peter in 1978, he became the youngest pope since Pius IX 100 years before and the first Polish pope. John Paul II visited every continent except Antarctica, logged over 1,000,000 miles, and greeted hundreds of millions of the faithful through his travels and papal audiences. He opened dialogues with Protestant denominations; visited Auschwitz, a Jewish synagogue, and a Muslim mosque; and made pilgrimages to Orthodox countries where no pope had ever been. His legacy includes more than a dozen encyclicals and scores of apostolic letters, constitutions, and exhortations. He beatified and canonized more than 1,000 men and women from all walks of life. He was tireless in his work for the poor and powerless, speaking out against war, economic injustice, political oppression, and what he called the industrialized world’s “culture of death.” Pope John Paul II’s ultimate homily was his own life,

Due to health and safety concerns, mass attendance is limited to 18 spaces in St. Patrick’s church, and 30 spaces in St. Joseph’s. Members of a single household can enter, sit, and exit together. Doors will be closed once maximum capacity has been met. The 10:00 am and 12:00 pm mass will be live streamed.

Facial coverings over your mouth and nose will be required to enter the church and must be worn throughout the mass except when receiving communion. Children under 2 and people with breathing problems are exempt from this order. Children under 12 are not required to wear facial coverings, though are strongly encouraged to wear one. Upon entering the church please stop at the hand sanitizer station use the hand sanitizer provided while maintaining the recommended 6 feet apart social distancing at all time. After each mass, a small group of people will sanitize the church.

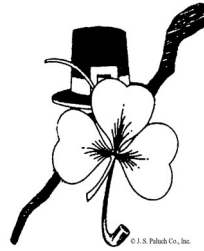
