



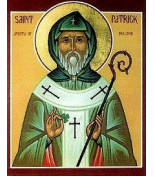

SOMETHING NEW IN CHRIST

Jesus knew that the scribes and Pharisees were trying to trap him. They put him in what seemed to be a no-win situation. Let the woman who was caught in adultery go, and he would have been accused of ignoring the law. Let her be stoned, and he would fail to show mercy toward her, contradicting his life's message. Jesus' response teaches three crucial lessons: none of us is free of sin; we are not the ultimate judges of others; Jesus is the mercy of God, in whom we can always trust. 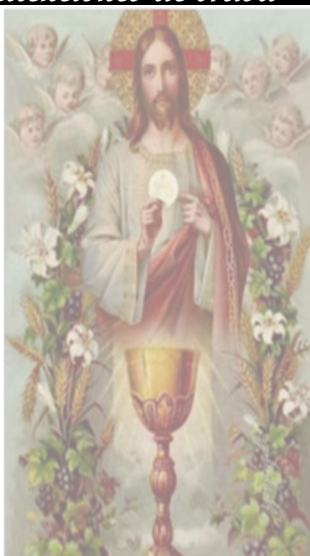

REFLECTIONS ON READINGS

April 3, 2022

Fifth Sunday of Lent

In our Gospel today we hear an ancient story, but one that feels like it could be taken out of the headlines today. We can be very quick to pass judgment on others, those with different political or cultural backgrounds, or perhaps with a different sexual orientation. Jesus was teaching in the temple, and the scribes and Pharisees did not like the message that he was proclaiming or the popularity he was gaining. When a nearby woman was caught in adultery, they thought it was the perfect chance to trip Jesus up, wondering how he would respond when the Mosaic Law provided clear consequences for such behavior. Many would be able to quote instantly chapter and verse of the law pertaining to the infraction. Instead of answering their question, Jesus turned it back on the accusers: "Let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her."



REFLEXIONES SOBRE LAS LECTURAS

3 de abril de 2022

Quinto Domingo de Cuaresma

En nuestro Evangelio de hoy escuchamos una historia antigua, pero que se siente como si pudiera ser sacada de los titulares de hoy. Podemos ser muy rápidos a la hora de juzgar a los demás, a los que tienen un trasfondo político o cultural diferente, o tal vez una orientación sexual distinta. Jesús estaba enseñando en el templo, y a los escribas y fariseos no les gustaba el mensaje que proclamaba ni la popularidad que estaba ganando. Cuando una mujer cercana fue sorprendida en adulterio, que era la oportunidad perfecta para ponerle la zancadilla a Jesús, preguntándose cómo respondería cuando la ley mosaica establecía claras consecuencias para ese comportamiento. Muchos serían capaces de citar al instante el capítulo y el versículo de la ley correspondiente a la infracción. En lugar de responder a su pregunta, Jesús se volvió contra los acusadores: "Aquel de ustedes que esté libre de pecado sea el primero en arrojar una piedra".

ESCRIBIR EN LA ARENA

Esperando la respuesta de los que le desafiaban, Jesús se agachó y escribió en la arena. Según el bibliófilo John Pilch, se trataba de una técnica sencilla que los campesinos utilizaban para ganar tiempo en una discusión o en un argumento. En lugar de mirar a los ojos a los escribas y fariseos, miraba hacia abajo y hacía lo suyo, aunque todos se escabullían. Las Escrituras no nos dicen qué hacía la mujer durante ese tiempo. Pero al no mirarla, Jesús le dio la oportunidad de recuperar su propia dignidad. No hizo ningún comentario sobre su inocencia o culpabilidad. Al contrario, le ordenó que saliera y no pecara más. No es nuestro pasado lo que importa, sino las decisiones que tomamos ahora y en el futuro. Una y otra vez, Dios nos da la oportunidad de volver a empezar nuestra vida. Este es nuestro reto en esta Cuaresma, seguir aprovechando las oportunidades que se nos dan para arrepentirnos y crecer.

DRAWING IN THE SAND

Awaiting the response of those challenging him, Jesus bent over and wrote in the sand. According to scripture scholar John Pilch, this was a simple technique that peasants used to buy time in a discussion or argument. Instead of looking the scribes and pharisees in the eye, he looked down and did his own thing while they all slipped away. The scriptures do not tell us what the woman was doing during this time. But by not looking at her, Jesus gave her a chance to restore her own dignity. He didn't comment on her innocence or guilt. Rather, he instructed her to go forth and sin no more. It is not our past that matters as much as the choices we make now and in the future. Again and again, God gives us the chance to start our life over. This is our challenge this Lent, to continue to use the opportunities we are given to repent and grow.

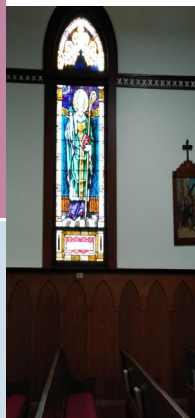

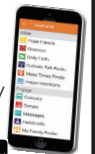
