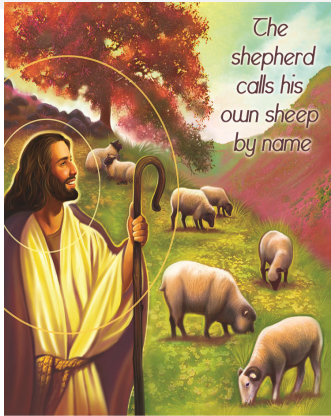

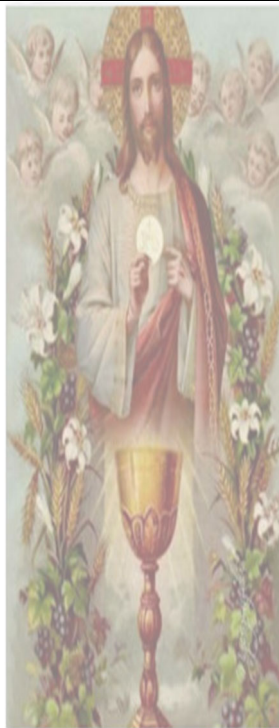

Vocaciones

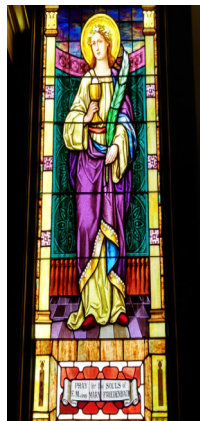
